

The Duel Pan Two Hander

The *Duel Pan two-hander*. One audio track is to be broadcast in the left hand channel whilst a second audio track is simultaneously to be broadcast in the right hand channel. By adjusting the balance control on their radio set the listener can choose to listen either to the track in the left, the track in the right, or a collage of the two tracks.
